Extradition: Continued Application to Swaziland of the United States-United Kingdom Treaty of December 22, 1931

KINGDOM OF SWAZILAND DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS

The Department of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Swaziland presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America and has the honour to refer to the Extradition Treaty signed by the United States of America and the United Kingdom on 22 December, 1931 and applied to the Kingdom of Swaziland prior to the restoration of its Independence on 6 September 1968.

The Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland, after having examined and considered the said Treaty, has decided to accept the responsibilities and obligations of the Treaty, and shall regard it as binding between the United States of America and the Kingdom of Swaziland. The Department wishes to propose that this Note and a reply indicating concurrence by the Government of the United States of America shall constitute an agreement between the two Governments in this matter. The Department of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Swaziland avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurance of its highest consideration.

The American Embassy to the Department of Foreign Affairs of Swaziland No. 17 The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Swaziland and has the honor to refer to the note of the Department of Foreign Affairs dated May 13, 1970 regarding the continuation in force between the United States of America and the Kingdom of Swaziland of the Extradition Treaty signed by the United States and the United Kingdom on December 22, 1931. The Government of the United States of America agrees that the above-mentioned Treaty shall be considered as continuing in force between our two Governments. Accordingly, your note and the present note in reply shall constitute the formal agreement between the two Governments in this matter. The Embassy avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Department of Foreign Affairs the assurances of its highest consideration.
